Resolution 11/13

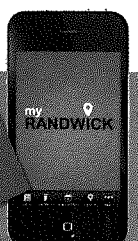
The Precinct's suggestion for an alcohol ban across all reserves in Coogee has been forwarded to Council's Technical Services for consideration.

Resolution 14/13
