#### Coogee Precinct Meeting 20 May 2013

Thank you for the minutes of this meeting of the Coogee Precinct. The Council notes the contents of these minutes and I am able to provide you with the following information in response to resolutions of the meeting.

#### Resolution 19/13


The bus shelters on the eastern side of Arden Street, Coogee adjacent to Goldstein Reserve were designed and constructed in keeping with the other buildings and shelters throughout the Reserve. Due to a high rate of vandalism associated with bus shelters, it is Council's preference that glass panels are not installed at these locations.

The openings in the shelter near Coogee Bay Road are required to allow an appropriate line of sight for approaching buses. Unfortunately, bus shelters cannot be constructed to protect bus patrons from all weather conditions.

#### Resolution 22/13

As part of Council's ranger patrols along our coastal areas, Rangers have spoken to several commercial groups operating on public roads and requested that they stop the unauthorised activity. Council's monitoring indicates that these groups have stopped operating on public roads.
